Brief Introduction of FBISE

Brief Introduction of Urdu(International)

The main purpose of Urdu (International) is to assess the reading and writing skills of students. It is compatible with national curriculum of Urdu 2006 implemented in Pakistan. It comprises of two papers i.e. (i) Reading & Writing and (ii) Essay. Following are the objectives of Urdu (International):

- Develop the ability in students to communicate confidently and clearly in Urdu.
- A sound understanding of the nature of language, skills and abilities required for further study.
- Insight into the culture and contemporary society of countries where Urdu is spoken.
- Better integration into communities where Urdu is spoken.
- Skills which can be used in other areas of learning, such as analysis and memory skills.
- Develop skills of languages in learner that can understand language from different angles.



Guidelines (instructions) for the paper of Reading and Writing

- 1. Two unseen passages in Urdu are set which deal with related themes. The passages will be selected from content (Urdu) written during the past twenty years. The passages must be free from religious, social, moral and political biasness which may cause unrest in the societies.
- 2. The two passages, taken together, will not exceed 750 words.
- 3. On the first passage, two tests (5 marks each) will be asked that cover vocabulary recognition and grammatical manipulation (singular, plural; synonym, antonym; masculine, feminine; idioms; words meaning; prefixes, suffixes; and sentence construction).







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- 4. There will be two questions (each of 15 marks) based separately on the two passages (one question from each passage). Each of the 15 marks question will further comprise of a series of short response questions (5 7 questions). In addition to this, for each of the two questions, an additional 5 marks will be awarded for quality of language.
- 5. The last question will be comprised of two parts and students will be required to write about 140 words, drawing information from both passages and adding their own opinions, (10 marks for information drawn from the passages, 5 marks for personal response to the material, and 5 marks for Quality of Language).





Summary of marks distribution (Paper of Reading and Writing)

Section I:

5 + 5 = 10

Section II:

15 + 5 = 20, 15 + 5 = 20

Section III:

10 + 5 + 5 = 20

Total Marks:

10 + 40 + 20 = 70





Guidelines (instructions) for the paper of Essay Writing

- Five essays will be selected from the given list of topic areas which will be included in the 2026 examinations.
- A candidates will choose one essay from the given topics and write an essay in Urdu of 250–400 words.







Prescribed Topic Areas for Essay Examination 2026

- 1. Generation Gap (نسلى تفاوت)
- 2. Health and fitness (صحت اور تندرستی)
- 3. Education (تعليم)
- 4. Technological Inventions (سائنسی ایجادات)
- 5. Protection of Environment (ماحولياتي اآلودگي/ماحول كاتحفظ)






Duration of Urdu (International)

- One Academic Year
- 180 Teaching Hours





Passing Criteria for Urdu (International)

- Passing the Reading and Writing paper individually is mandatory.
- Passing the Essay paper individually is also mandatory.
- Minimum 40% marks are required in each paper.





Eligibility Criteria

- Secondary School certificate (SSC) / O' Level or equivalent level completed
- Both regular and private students are eligible





Regular Students (REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION BOTH)

- Registration is mandatory for regular students in the beginning of academic session
- Regular students will submit admission forms along with fee to the FBISE before appearing in examination
