- 1. Single stage two envelopes bidding procedure will be adopted as per PPRA rules. The bid security of Rs.500,000/- for the Lab Investigation Services upto the Calendar year 2026-27 in the shape of CDR/Bank Chequer/Pay Order in the name of PLS Earnest Money Account, Account No. 22117900008201 in favor of FBISE, Islamabad is required to be submitted and will be attached with the Technical Proposal.
- 2. Sealed bid Proposals are required to be brought in person by the authorized representatives of the interested bidders before or on 08/01/2026 till 10:00 AM positively. The Technical Proposals received till stipulated date and time shall be opened on the same day at 10.30 AM in conference room in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives.

Test of Responsiveness

- 3. No offer shall be considered if:-
 - Received without CDR/Bank Chequer/Pay Order and receipt regarding purchase of bidding document.
 - Received after the date and time fixed for it.
 - The bid proposals are unsigned.
 - The offer is ambiguous.
 - The offer is conditional.
 - The offer is by telegram/Courier.
 - The offer is from a firm black listed, suspended
 - The offer received with shorter validity than required in the tender inquiry.
- **4.** The bidders are required to give their best and final competitive prices as far as possible.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

1. Eligible Bidders: This invitation for bid is open to all medical centers/Lab Investigation Services/Lab Firms providing Lab Investigations facilities within All Pakistan.

THE BIDDING PROCEDURE

- **2. Single Stage two Envelopes:** bidding procedures shall be applied:
 - **i.** The bid shall comprise a single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelope shall contain separately the Technical Proposal and the Financial proposal.
 - **ii.** The envelopes shall be marked as "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" and "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion.
 - iii. Initially, only the envelope marked "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" shall be opened.
 - **iv.** The envelope marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" shall be retained in the Custody of the FBISE without being opened.
 - **v.** The FBISE shall evaluate technical proposals, without references to the price and reject any proposal which do not conform to the specified requirements.
 - vi. During the technical evaluation, no amendments in the technical proposal shall be permitted.
 - vii. The financial proposal of bids shall be opened publically at a time, date and Venue to be announced and communicated to bidders in advance.
 - **viii.** After evaluation and approval of the technical proposal, the FBISE shall at a time within the bid validity period, publically open the financial proposal of the technically accepted bids only.
 - **ix.** The financial proposals of technically disqualified bidders shall be returned un-opened to the respective bidders.
 - **x.** The Financial Proposal, found to be the collectively lowest (collectively means sum up/accumulated offered price/cost of all required tests at Annexure-A) evaluated Proposal, shall be considered as successful and accepted proposal.

THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

3. Contents of bidding documents:

- i. The Lab tests required, bidding procedure, and Contract terms are prescribed in the bidding documents. In addition to Invitation for Bids, the bidding documents shall include:
 - a. Instruction to bidders
 - b. Schedule of requirements
 - c. Technical specifications
 - d. Contract form
 - e. Bid Form
 - f. Price Schedule
 - g. Price Reasonability Certificate
 - h. Certificate on stamp Paper of worth Rs.100/-
- ii. General and special conditions regarding purchase and procurement as given in the Procurement
- **iii.** The Bidders are expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bidding documents.
- **iv.** Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or to submit a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents in every respect shall be at the bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its bid.
- 4. Clarification of Bidding Documents: A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding

documents may notify the FBISE, in writing. The FBISE shall respond in writing to any request for clarification of the bidding documents, which it receives no later than ten (10) days prior to the deadline for the submission of bids prescribed in identifying the source of inquiry shall be sent to all prospective bidders that have received the bidding documents.

5. Amendment of Bidding Documents: At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the FBISE, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder may modify the bidding documents by amendment. All prospective bidders that received the bidding documents shall be notified of the amendment in writing or by phone, and shall be bidding on them.

PREPATATION OF BIDS

6. Documents Comprising the bid:

The bid shall comprise of the following components:

- **a.** Bid Form and Price Schedule completed in accordance with instruction to bidder is (to be submitted along with financial proposal)
- **b.** Documentary evidence established in accordance with instructions to bidders that the bidder is Eligible to bid and is qualified to perform the Contract if its bid is accepted.
- **c.** Documentary evidence established in accordance with instruction to bidders that the Lab tests to be supplied by the bidder are eligible Lab tests and conform to the bidding documents;
- **d.** Bid security in accordance with instruction to bidders.
- **7. Bid Form & Price Schedule:** The bidder shall complete the bid and an appropriate price schedule furnished in the bidding documents, indicating the investigation facility to be provided by the Medical Centre/Lab Investigation Services/Medical Firm.

8. Bid Prices:

- i. The bidder shall indicate an appropriate price schedule i.e. the unit price (rate per test), it proposes to service under the contract.
- **ii.** Form of price is to be filled in very carefully, preferably typed. Any alteration/correction initialed. Every page is to be signed and stamped at the bottom. Total number of the pages of bid must be mentioned. Serial number of the quoted item may be marked with red/yellow marker.
- **iii.** The bidder should quote the price of Lab tests according to the strength/technical specification as provided in the form of price schedule and technical specifications. The specifications of Lab tests, different from the demand of bid enquiry, shall straight away be rejected.
- **iv.** The bidder is required to offer competitive price. All prices must include (if applicable) the General Sale Tax (GST) and other taxes and duties, (where applicable). If there is no mention of taxes, the offered quoted price shall be considered as inclusive of all prevailing taxes/duties. The benefit of exemption from or reduction in the GST or other taxes shall be passed to FBISE.
- **v.** Prices offered should be for the whole period upto Calendar Year 2026-27. Conditional offer shall be considered as non-responsive bid.
- **vi.** While tendering your quotation, the present trend/ inflation in the rate of Lab tests in the market should be kept in mind. No request for increase in price due to market fluctuation in the cost of Lab tests shall be entertained.

9. Documents Establishing Bidder's Qualification

- i. The bidder shall furnish, as part of its technical bid, documents establishing the bidder' eligibility to bid and its qualifications to perform the contract if its bid is accepted.
- ii. The documentary evidence of the bidder's eligibility to bid shall establish to FBISE Satisfaction that bidder, at the time of submission of its bid, is an eligible bidder as defined under instruction to the bidders.
- **iii.** (Where Applicable) The sole agent/ importer shall have to produce letter of authorization from Manufacturer (Foreign Principal)and in case of manufacturer, documentary proof including manufacturing license/registration certificate, to the effect that they are the original manufacturer of required specifications of Lab tests, shall be provided.
- **iv.** National Tax Number (NTN) and General Sale Tax (GST) PRA (if applicable) with documentary proof shall have to be provided by each bidder in tender.
- **v.** The bidder shall submit an affidavit on legal stamp paper Rs. 100/- that their firm is not black listed on any ground by any Government (Federal/province /district), a local body or public sector organization. The bidder shall be debarred from bid on account of submission of false statement; furthermore rates quoted at FBISE, Head Office, Islamabad are not more than the rates quoted at any Govt./Semi Govt./Autonomous.
- **vi.** The bidder should have minimum Two Years' experience in the market of providing facility of test to general public. Similarly, it is mandatory that for investigation /procedure to be quoted by the bidder/manufacturer Documentary proof shall have to provide.
- **vii.** The bidder is required to provide with the technical proposal, the name of investigation/procedure along with serial number for which they have quoted their rates in the financial proposals.
- **viii.** The Bidder must indicate the registration number, make and model of Machines available at the Lab/Medical Centre/Hospital.

10. Documents Establishing Lab Tests eligibility and conformity to bidding documents:

The bidder shall furnish along with Technical Proposal, as part of bid, documents establishing the eligibility and conformity to the bidding documents of all Lab tests which the bidder proposes to supply under the contact.

11. Bid Security/Performance Guarantee:

i. Bid Security: The bidder shall provide Bid security amounting to Rs.500,000/- form of CDR/Bank Chequer/Pay Order along with their bid proposals on the name of Account-PLS Earnest Money, Account No. 22117900008201.

ii. Performance Guarantee:

The successful bidder will provide 10% performance guarantee of the value of award letter. The performance guarantee is required to protect FBISE against the risk of bidder's conduct, which would warrant the performance security forfeiture, pursuant to instruction to bidders.

iii. The Bid Security may be forfeited:

- a. If a bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity; or
- b. In case of a successful bidder, if the bidder fails:
 - **i.** To sign the contract in accordance with instruction to bidders.
 - ii. To provide the Lab Investigation Services in accordance with General Condition of Contract.

12. Bid Validity:

- i. Bids shall remain valid for the period of **Six (06) Months (180 Days)** after the date of opening of Technical Bid, Prescribed by the FBISE. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected as non-responsive.
- **ii.** FBISE shall ordinarily be under an obligation to process and evaluate the bid within the stipulated bid validity period. However, under exceptional circumstance and for reason to be recorded in writing, if an extension is considered necessary, all those who have submitted their bids shall be asked to extend their respective bid validity period. Such extension shall be for not more than the equal to the period of the original bid validity.

iii. Bidders Who:

- a. **Agree** the FBISE's request for extension of bid validity period shall not be permitted to change the substance of their bids; and
- b. Do not agree to an extension of the validity period shall be allowed to withdraw their bids without forfeiture of their bid Securities.

13. Format and Signature of Bid:

- i. The bidder shall prepare and submit its bid along with original purchase receipt. The bid shall be typed signed by the bidder or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the bidder to the contract. The person or persons signing the bid shall initial all pages of the bid, except for amended printed literature.
- **ii.** Any inter lineation; erase or overwriting shall be valid only if they are initialed by the person or persons singing the bid.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

14. Sealing and Marking of Bids:

- i. The envelopes shall be marked as "Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal" in bold legible letters to avoid confusion. The inner and outer envelopes shall:
 - a. Be addressed to the Director (P&S), FBISE and;
 - b. Bear the name and number indicated in the invitation for Bids.
 - c. Every page of the financial proposal scheduled by signed and stamped by bidder himself.
- **ii.** The inner envelops shall also indicate the name and address of the bidder to enable the bid returned unopened in case it is declared as "non-responsive" or "late".

15. Deadline for Submission of Bids: -

Bids must be submitted by the bidder and received by FBISE, not later than the time and date specified in the invitation for bids. The Director (P&S), FBISE may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of bids by amending the bidding documents in accordance with instruction to bidder, in which case all rights and obligations of the FBISE and bidder previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

16. Late Bid: -

Any bid received after the deadline for the submission of bid's prescribed, shall be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

17. Withdrawal of bids:-

The bidder may withdraw its bid after the bid's submission and prior the deadline prescribed for submission of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the period of bid validity specified in instruction to bidders. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval may result in the Bidder's forfeiture of its Bid Security, pursuant to the instruction to bidders

OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

1. Opening of Bids:-

Initially only the envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" shall be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend the meeting at time, on the date specified already in the Conference Room of Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, H-8/4, Islamabad. The bidders' representatives who are present shall sign the attendance sheet evidencing their attendance. However, the envelope Marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" shall be retained in the custody of FBISE without being opened and till completion of the Evaluation process.

2. Clarification of Bids:-

During Evaluation of the bids, the authority may at its discretion, ask the bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

3. Preliminary Examination:-

All the bids shall be examined to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids generally in order.

- i. In the financial bids the arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and total price shall be corrected. If the bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid shall be rejected, and its security may be forfeited. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
- **ii.** Any minor informality, nonconformity, irregularity in a bid which does not constitute a material deviation, may be waived such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any bidder.
- **iii.** If a bid is not substantially responsive, it shall be rejected and may not subsequently be made responsive by the bidder by correction of the non-conformity.

4. Evaluation & Comparison of Bids:-

- i. Substantially responsive bid shall be evaluated and compared.
- **ii.** The Evaluation of technical proposal/bid shall be on the basis of previous performance, pervious test report, previous experience, financial soundness and such other details as the authority, at its discretion, may consider appropriate, shall be considered, however, the evaluation of the financial proposal shall be on the basis of price inclusive of prevailing taxes and duties in pursuant to instruction to bidder and bid security.
- **iii.** All bids shall be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria and other terms & conditions set forth in these bidding documents.
- **iv.** A bid on reopened in accordance with the prescribed procedure shall be subject to only those rules, regulations and policies that are enforce at the time of issue of notice for invitation of bids.

5. Evaluation Criteria:-

- i. For the purpose of determining the lowest evaluated bid, facts other than price such as performance, previous, financial soundness and such other details as the authority, at its discretion may consider appropriate shall be taken into consideration. The given merit point system for weighing evaluation factors/criteria shall be applied for the TECHNICAL PROPOSALS. The number of points allocated to each factor shall be specified in the evaluation report.
- ii. After technical evaluation is completed, the bidders who have submitted proposals shall be informed about technical scores obtained through technical evaluation criteria and shall notify those bidders whose proposal did not meet the minimum qualifying mark which is 70% or were considered non responsive, that their financial proposals shall be returned unopened after completing the selection process. It shall be simultaneously notified in writing to the bidders that they have secured the minimum qualifying marks, the date, time and location for opening the financial proposals. Bidder's attendance at the opening of financial proposals is optional.
- **iii.** Financial proposals shall be opened publicly in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend. The Name of the bidders and the technical score of the bidder shall be read aloud. The Financial proposal of the bidders who met the minimum qualifying marks shall then be opened and quoted price read aloud and recoded if appropriate.
- **6. Qualification & Disqualification Of Bidder:-** A bidder shall be disqualified if it would be finding, at any time, that the information submitted by him concerning his qualification was false and materially inaccurate or incomplete.
- **7. Rejection of Bid:** The Deputy Secretary (P&S) shall upon request communicate to bidder who submitted a bid, the ground for its rejection of any or all bids, but is not required to justify those grounds. The FBISE incurs no liability, solely towards bidder who has submitted bid. Notice of the rejection of any or bids shall be given promptly to the concerned bidders that submitted bids.
- **8. Announcement of Evaluation Report:** The results of bid evaluation shall be declared prior to the award of procurement contract in the form of report giving justification for acceptance or rejection of bids at least ten days prior to the award of procurement contract.
- **9. Grievance Redressal Committee:-**Under rule 67 of PPRA Rules 2014, any firm aggrieved of the evaluation report may submitting writing the grievance to Procuring agency within 10 days of the announcement of the evaluation report and the procuring agency shall nominate a Grievance Redressal Committee comprising of the odd number of members to address the grievance of aggrieved firms within15 days of the receipt of the grievance of the firm. And the procuring agency shall inform the decision of the Grievance Redressal Committee to the firm.

Award of Contract

- 10. Acceptance of Bid and Award Criteria: The bidder with the lowest (collectively means sum up/accumulated cost of all required tests at Annexure-A) evaluated bid, if not in conflict with any other law, rules, regulations or policy of the provincial Government, shall be awarded the letter of approval of rates, within the original or extended period of bid validity. The approved rates will remain valid up to 31.12.2027 which may further be extendable for period of another three months.
 - i. The approved Lab /Medical Centre will be responsible for provision of facility of Lab Investigations as per approved rates.
 - ii. In case of non-provision of the facility. Firm will be bound to provide facility of the tests

from any other Centre/ Lab and in case of failure, the amount will be deducted from the payment/security of the firm or the price difference shall be paid by the firm.

- **11. Sub contracts:-** The suppliers shall not be allowed to sublet the job and award sub contracts under this contract.
- **12. Delays in the supplier's performance:-** Investigations of our patients should be done on priority for timely delivery of the services. The service provider/suppliers shall promptly notify the FBISE hospital in writing of the fact of delay its likely duration and its cause(s).
- **13. Penalties/Liquidated Damage:**-If the firm fails to provide the services due to any unavoidable circumstances the firm will be responsible for the investigation to be done from any sources or the price difference shall be paid by the firm.
- 14. Termination For Default:- The FBISE without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to service provider/Suppliers, may terminate the Contract in whole or in part, if the service provider/suppliers fails to deliver any or all service within the period (s) specified in the Contract, or within any extension therefore granted or if the service provider fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Contract and if the suppliers, in the judgment of FBISE has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract.
 - A) In case the firm fails to execute the contract satisfactorily with the FBISE, the FBISE reserves the right to purchase the item from the market at the risk and cost of defaulting Lab firm. The FBISE also reserves the right for the suspension/ cancellation of Contract/ blacklisting/firm.
 - B) If the firm fails to execute the contract/ supply order satisfactorily then the FBISE reserves the right to forfeit the security of the contractor and may award the contract to the second lowest bidder.
- **15. Arbitration and resolution of disputes:-** In case of any dispute, decision of the Chairman, FBISE would be final however:
 - i. The procuring agency and the supplier shall make every effort to resolve the disagreement or disputes arising between them amicably, if any in connection with the Contract, by direct informal negotiation.
 - **ii.** If, after thirty (30 days) from the commencement of such informal negotiation, the procuring Agency and the supplier have been unable to resolve Amicably a Contract dispute, either party may require that the dispute be referred to the Arbitrator for resolution through arbitration.
 - **iii.** In case of any dispute concerning the interpretation and / or application of this contract shall be settled through arbitration. Chairman, FBISE shall act as sole arbitrator. The Decisions taken and / or award made by the Chairman FBISE shall be final and binding on the parties.

NOTE: All assessments and procedures i.e. receiving, opening and awarding etc., shall be governed by the Procurement Rules, 2014
